TOWCESTER

The Roman town of Lactodorum, standing on Watling Street developed into a Saxon town and after the Conquest, continued to be of strategic importance leading to the building of the castle. The centre of the town remains its market square, with handsome Georgian buildings, shops and restaurants and terminating at the far end by the Italo-German Town Hall. Behind the market square lies the church and remains of the castle, now surrounded by a sympathetic new development and the town brewery.


